## ONLINE SERVICE

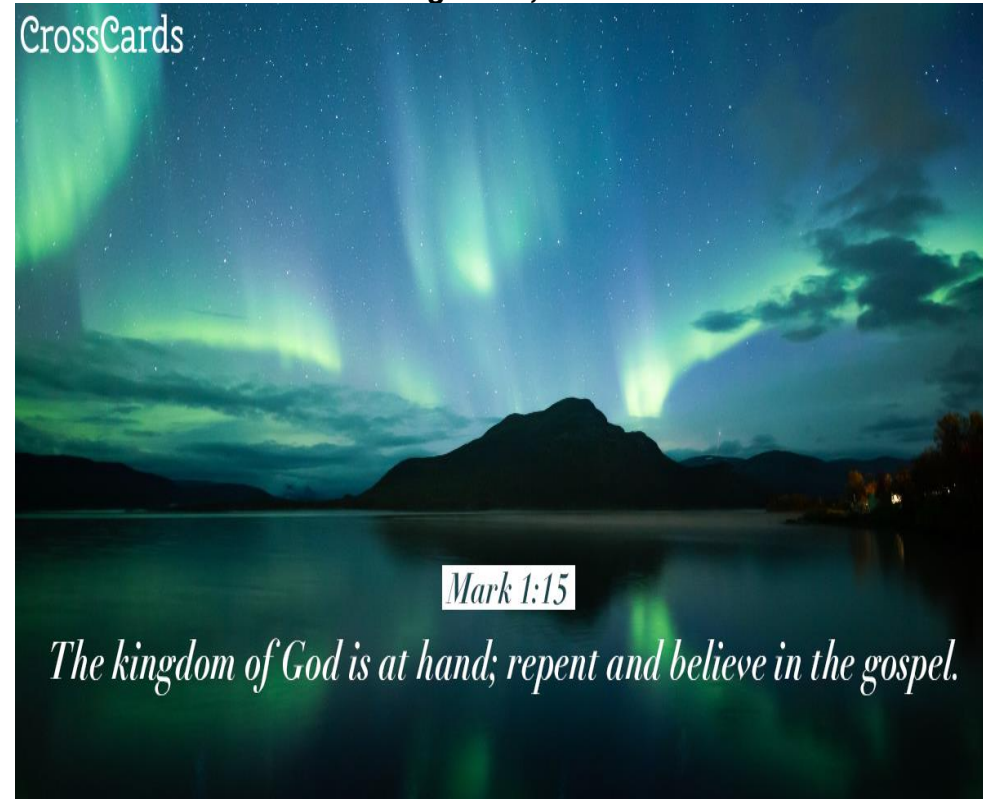
