GROWING IN GRACE COMMUNITY STUDIES

Our Growing in Grace Community Study continues Wednesday's at 7:00 p.m. We look forward to your joining us as we begin **the study titled" Ephesians: The Inheritance We Have in Christ" ...** by Dr. David Jeremiah. In Ephesians Paul gives us a reminder of our identity in Christ. We will follow Dr. Jeremiah through the letter of Ephesians in a chapter-by-chapter study that will help you understand what it meant to the people at the time it was written, and what it means to Christians today. Ephesus was located in a region where Christianity and pagan religions were clashing. However, the apostle Paul saw an opportunity to advance the kingdom of God. In the letter to the Ephesians, Paul walks believers through their spiritual inheritance in Christ. This inheritance moves them from death to life and into God's family—something so much better than anything they had in their former lives. Because of this, they need to *"walk worthy of their calling,"* understand and use their spiritual gifts, and put on the armor of God. Each of this study's twelve lessons is clearly organized for easy understanding and provides for nourishing discussion. All are welcome to join.
